They share voting and investment control over all securities owned by Special Situations Fund III QP, LP (QP), Special Situations Cayman Fund, L.P. (Cayman), Special Situations Technology Fund, LP (Tech) and Special Situations Technology Fund II, L.P. (Tech II), respectively. 743,163 shares of Common Stock are held by QP, 262,944 shares of Common Stock are held by Cayman, 35,606 shares of Common Stock are held by Tech and 176,921 shares of Common Stock are held by Tech II. The interest of Marx and Greenhouse in the shares of Common Stock owned by QP, Cayman, Tech and Tech II is limited to the extent of his pecuniary interest.
